# **Requirements for Earning and Maintaining Certification**

## 1. Intentional Peer Support Specialists Training

- □ Peer Support 101
- Application Process
  - **•** Reviewed by consumers
- Web Training
  - Includes learning styles assessment
- 10-days classroom training
  - **u** Must not miss more than five hours of classroom time.
- Completion of final test
  If test is not completed entire training must be repeated.

### 2. Quarterly Co-Supervision

• Co-Supervision 1 time per quarter - may attend more frequently.

### 3. Continuing Education

- Two continuing Education Classes Per Year
- Continuing Ed options will also be offered at the Recovery Conference.

#### 4. 75-hours of Peer Support per year

- Documented quarterly.
- 5. Certification is issued upon completion of all requirements.
- Requirements must be met within one year of completion of Peer Support Specialists Training.
- Co Supervision, Continuing Education and 75-hours Peer Support requirements must be met each year to maintain yearly certification.
