Requirements for Earning and Maintaining Certification

1. Intentional Peer Support Specialists Training

- ❑ Peer Support 101
- ❑ Application Process
 - ❑ Reviewed by consumers
- ❑ Web Training
 - ❑ Includes learning styles assessment
- ❑ 10-days classroom training
 - ❑ Must not miss more than five hours of classroom time.
- ❑ Completion of final test
 - ❑ If test is not completed – entire training must be repeated.

2. Quarterly Co-Supervision

- ❑ Co-Supervision 1 time per quarter - may attend more frequently.

3. Continuing Education

- ❑ Two continuing Education Classes Per Year
- ❑ Continuing Ed options will also be offered at the Recovery Conference.

4. 75-hours of Peer Support per year

- ❑ Documented quarterly.

5. Certification is issued upon completion of all requirements.

- ❑ Requirements must be met within one year of completion of Peer Support Specialists Training.
- ❑ Co Supervision, Continuing Education and 75-hours Peer Support requirements must be met each year to maintain yearly certification.
